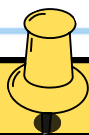

Coming up.....

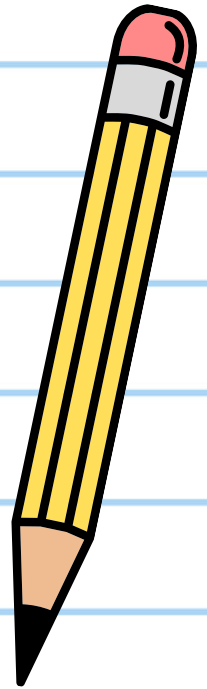
16.7.26 Last Day of term for pupils

Mobile Phones

A reminder that the Governments statutory guidance on the use of mobile phones in school goes live in September. Our new Mobile Phone policy will be available from September too. A reminder that there is to be no use of mobile phones during school hours by pupils. For the very few pupils who use a phone as part of their regulation on transport, this will need to be handed in to class staff at the start of the day and returned at the end of the day. There are a very small number of exceptions, whose families we have already spoken to. Many thanks in advance for your support with this matter.

Hydro in the Autumn Term.

We are very fortunate to have our hydro pool as an invaluable resource at Oak View School. As you can imagine, it takes a lot to maintain and run the facility. There is also very high demand for the use of it. To prolong the longevity of the pool there are only so many slots for usage each day (most of the day), but the demand from pupils outweighs the number of slots; therefore some adjustments are required moving forward. Priority has been given to pupils who require sessions for physio/medical programmes. Some pupils who have accessed it for two sessions a week will only have one session moving forward, and some pupils will access sessions in half termly blocks and not all through the school year.

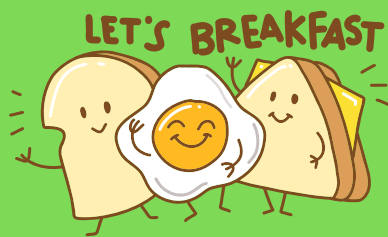
